Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of **CEL Properties, LLC** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the FJ-FK Zone, Reservoir A, Maurice Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 123 acres for the FJ-FK Zone, Reservoir A, Maurice Field, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana, designated as the FJ-FK RA SUA, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said unit;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The FJ-FK Zone, Reservoir A in the Maurice Field is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 14,466 feet and 15,050 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Energy Development Corp.-D. J. Denais No. 1 Well, located in Section 35, Township 10 South, Range 3 East, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, a pre-application conference was held in Lafayette, Louisiana on November 17, 2010. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a list of the names and addresses of the parties who were in attendance at that conference.

The conference was opened by Mr. B. J. Duplantis. Mr. David Comeaux of Leon Comeaux & Associates presented the plan of applicant. Questions were asked and answered. Our plan has been slightly revised, increasing the acreage to 123 acres. Mr. Jim Hardwick on behalf of the Robertson Family presented a plan with a slightly different current water level for the FJ Sand. The parties will continue to attempt to work out their differences.





