

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 4, 2011**, upon the application of **KEY OPERATING COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Eocene Zone, Reservoir A, SUA**, in the Washington Field, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Eocene Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To create a drilling and production unit for the exploration and production of gas and condensate from the Eocene Zone, Reservoir A.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis.
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such a reclassification be warranted based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Eocene Zone is defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the electric log depths of 8,720' and 10,220' in the Atlantic Refining Company-Wallace Hardy No. 1 Well (SN 81732), located in Section 27, Township 4 South, Range 5 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
