

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes, of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 11, 2011**, upon the application of **HAWKEYE DRILLING CO.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Miocene Zone, Reservoirs A and B**, in the Iberia Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations for the development of the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A and Miocene Zone, Reservoir B.
2. To establish three (3) drilling and production units for the exploration and production of oil and casinghead gas from the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A and one (1) drilling and production unit for the exploration and production of oil and casinghead gas from the Miocene Zone, Reservoir B.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract and owner sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To find that the available and geological engineering data indicate that the proposed drilling and production units are reasonable and should be adopted; that each unit can be effectively and economically drained by one well.
5. To acknowledge and determine that the Miocene Zone, Reservoirs A and B are in the immediate vicinity of a salt dome and, as such, are subject to complex faulting that makes the application of standard spacing rules under Statewide Order No. 29-E impracticable, and to therefore exempt any future completions or recompletions made in the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A and Miocene Zone, Reservoir B, from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To designate Hawkeye Drilling Co. as the operator of each established drilling unit.
7. To designate the orphaned wells identified with the hexagons on the plat submitted with the application, as the unit wells for each of the four (4) proposed units.
8. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A and/or Miocene Zone, Reservoir B, by Supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
9. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Miocene Zone, Reservoir A is defined as that oil and casinghead gas bearing zone encountered between the electric log depths of 630' and 1,949' (ELM) in the Tee Operating Co.-J.B. Schwing No. 4 Well, located in Section 56, Township 12 South, Range 7 East.

The Miocene Zone, Reservoir B is defined as that oil and casinghead gas bearing zone encountered between the electric log depths of 530' and 1,815' (ELM) in the Tribal Oil et al-J. B. Schwing No. 1 Well, located in Section 56, Township 12 South, Range 7 East.
