Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **DAVIS PETROLEUM CORP.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Landry "A" Sand, Reservoir A, in the Leleux Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated LAN "A" RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator and unit well for the proposed unit.
4. To provide that any wells drilled to the Landry "A" Sand, Reservoir A, within or outside the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the aforementioned sand and reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Landry "A" Sand, Reservoir A, in Leleux Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 10,620 feet and 10,664 feet (electrical log measurements) in the David Petroleum Corp. – R. Adam et al No. 1 Well, located in Section 13, Township 11 South, Range 1 East, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.




