Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **DESTIN OPERATING COMPANY** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Sparta "A" Sand, Reservoir A in the Opelousas Field, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and create a drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate in the Opelousas Field, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated SPA RA SUB.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation.
3. To permit the applicant, Destin Operating Company, to designate and utilize the Destin Operating Co.- Wilfred Lalonde No. 3 well as the unit well for SPA RA SUB as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof, located according to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Orders.
4. To designate **DESTIN OPERATING COMPANY** as the operator of the unit.
5. To provide that any future wells drilled in the SPA RA SUB should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To authorize the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. Except to the extent herein designated, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of the Office of Conservation Orders relating to the Opelousas Field, and all applicable Statewide Orders.
8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Sparta "A" Sand, in Opelousas Field, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 257- K as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,108 feet and 12,263 feet, electrical log depths in the Halbouty, et al.-Guillory No. 1 well (SN 129510), located in Section 117, Township 6 South, Range 4 East, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana. It was further defined in Office of The

Conservation Order No. 257-K-2 as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,178 feet and 12,333 feet (measured depths) or 12,100 feet and 12,255 feet (true vertical depths) in the Destin Operating Co.-Wilfred Lalonde, et al, No. 1 well (SN 240070) located in Section 117, Township 6 South, Range 4 East, St. Landry Parish, Louisiana.



Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure the conference which was scheduled for 10:30 A.M. on Thursday, December 2, 2010, at the Petroleum Club of Lafayette. 111 Heymann Blvd., Lafayette, Louisiana, was held relative to the creation of a unit for the Sparta A Sand, Reservoir A SUB in the Opelousas Field, St. Landry Parish. Mr. Frank Harrison, representing Destin Operation Co., Inc., opened the conference and explained the basis of the proposed unit. After the presentation a number of questions by the participants were answered. However, there was no opposition expressed or presented to Destin's proposed unit. Mr. Harrison then adjourned the conference. A copy of the list of all those attending the conference is attached.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the applicant's proposal and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Interested Parties, and Represented Parties to whom a copy of this notice is being furnished. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation.
