Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **JORDAN OIL COMPANY** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the 13,500' Zone, Reservoir A, in Kings Bayou Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 13,500' Zone, Reservoir A, in the Kings Bayou Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana;
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the 13,500' Zone, Reservoir A, said proposed unit designated 13500 RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate a unit operator of the proposed 13500 RA SUA;
5. To provide that any wells drilled to the above mentioned zone, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E);
6. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order, without the necessity of a public hearing, should the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation; and

7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent to the 13,500' Zone, Reservoir A.

The 13,500' Zone, Reservoir A, in the Kings Bayou Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the electric log measured depths of 11420 and 14366 feet in the Red Willow Offshore, LLC– R.D. Sanders No.1 Well located in Section 22, Township 14 South, Range 7 West, Cameron Parish, Louisiana


