LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 25, 2011**, upon the application of **MIDSTATES PETROLEUM CO., LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **8,000' Zone, Reservoir G, Upper Wilcox Sand, Reservoir E and Wilcox Sand, Reservoir H**, in the Pine Prairie Field, Evangeline Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit for the 8,000' Zone, Reservoir G.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the Upper Wilcox Sand, Reservoir E.
3. To create a single drilling and production unit for the Wilcox Sand, Reservoir H.
4. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the said units.
5. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
6. To grant permission to applicant to combine downhole production from the 8000 RG SUA, U WX RE SUA and WX RH SUA in the wellbore of any existing and future wells located on said units. The interests of the working interest owners and royalty owners in the units are identical.
7. To continue in full force and effect the provisions of Series of Office of Conservation Order Nos. 32-P, Series of Order Nos. 32-J and Series of Order Nos. 32-K.
8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 8,000' Zone was previously defined in Order No. 32-P, effective January 8, 2008.

The Upper Wilcox Sand, Reservoir E is hereby identified as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,100' and 10,530' (electrical log measurements) in the Inexco Oil Company-Crowell Land & Mineral Corp. No. 3 Well, located in Section 23, Township 3 South, Range 1 West.

The Wilcox Sand, Reservoir H is hereby identified as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,305 and 11,470' (electrical log measurements) in the Inexco Oil Company-Crowell Land & Mineral Corp. No. 5 Well, located in Section 27, Township 3 South, Range 1 West.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
