LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 4, 2011**, upon the application of **ASPECT ENERGY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hackberry Zone, Reservoir B and Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir D**, in the Topsy Field, Allen and Jefferson Davis Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To create two (2) additional drilling and production units for the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir B and Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir D.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hackberry Zone, Reservoir B SUC and Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir D SUC.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate an operator of the proposed HBY RB SUC and NS RD SUC.
5. To provide that any wells drilled to the above mentioned zones, within or outside of the proposed units, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
6. To allow the Commissioner of Conservation to reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Order, without the necessity of a public hearing, should the producing characteristics of the reservoirs change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hackberry Zone, Reservoir B and Nonion Struma Zone, Reservoir D were previously defined in Office of Conservation Order Nos. 957-E-1 and 957-C-3, respectively.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
