SUGAR CREEK PRODUCING COMPANY ("Applicant") hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Travis Peak Sands of the Hosston Formation in the Sugar Creek Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit Applicant to complete, designate and utilize its Dobbins A No. 1 Well as an alternate unit well for TP SUH, said well being located as shown on the attached plat, in exception to the well spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 23-H, effective January 1, 1961.
2. To find that an alternate unit well for TP SUH is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Travis Peak Sands of the Hosston Formation underlying TP SUH which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within this unit.
3. To permit the operator of TP SUH to produce the allowable assigned to this unit from either the unit well, the alternate unit well, or from a combination of such wells, at the option of the operator.
4. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Travis Peak Sands of the Hosston Formation in the Sugar Creek Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana, is defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 23-H-3, effective September 22, 1977.

Any pertinent data concerning this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Mr. Joe B. Adams, 21010 Vermont Street, Livingston, Louisiana 70754. Any person wishing to inspect any such data should call Mr. Adams at (225) 686-2355 during normal business

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
hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data which is not otherwise available from the records of the Louisiana Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.

As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Pursuant to the aforesaid Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of this letter and of the attached plat is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to each of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Sugar Creek Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, a copy of the Legal Notice will be mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

A check payable to the Office of Conservation and covering the application fee is enclosed.




