

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2011**, upon the application of **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **E-2 Sand, Reservoir 495 and E-3 Sand, Reservoir 495**, in the Lake Barre Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company-U32 No. 30 Well, located in Township 21 South, Range 20 East, as a substitute unit well for the E-2 R495 SUA
2. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company-U32 No. 30 Well, located in Township 21 South, Range 20 East, as a substitute unit well for the E-3 R495 SUA.
3. To show that the proposed well is necessary and in the interest of conservation to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the E-2 R495 SUA which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within such unit. The present unit well, the U33 No. 21 Well, ceased to produce from the E-2 R495 SUA in December, 2006.
4. To show that the proposed well is necessary and in the interest of conservation to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the E-3 R495 SUA which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within such unit. The present unit well, the U33 No. 21 Well ceased to produce from the E-3 R495 SUA in March, 2000.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The E-2 Sand, Reservoir 495 was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 662-L-3, effective October 17, 2000.

The E-3 Sand, Reservoir 495 was fully defined in Order No. 662-P-2, effective February 22, 2000.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
