

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2011**, upon the application of **DUNN EXPLORATION COMPANY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Upper Motty Zone, Reservoir E**, in the Abbeville Field, Vermilion Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit applicant, Dunn Exploration Company, LLC to drill, designate and utilize the Dunn Exploration Company, LLC-Labit No. 1 Well as an alternate unit well for the U MOTTY RE SUA, such well to be at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the Upper Motty Zone, Reservoir E, which cannot be efficiently and economically be drained by any other well within the unit.
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the Upper Motty Zone, Reservoir E and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the alternate unit well, or from any combination at its option.
4. To confirm Dunn Exploration Company, LLC as operator of the Upper Motty Zone, Reservoir E.
5. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 155-K-6, effective November 4, 2010, shall remain in full force and effect.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Upper Motty Zone, Reservoir E was previously defined in Order No. 155-K-6, effective November 4, 2010.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
