

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2011**, upon the application of **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **TB2G-6 Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Caillou Island Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the TB2G-6 RA SUA, as established by Office of Conservation Order No. 411-VVVV, effective February 23, 2010, and simultaneously therewith, to create a revised unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the TB2G-6 Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate Hilcorp Energy Company as operator of the TB2G-6 RA SUA.
4. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company-SL 301 No. 293 Well as the unit well and the Hilcorp Energy Company-SL 301 No. 150 Well, SL 301 No. 156 Well, SL 301 No. 217 Well, SL 301 No. 247 Well, SL 301 No. 309 Well, SL 301 No. 321 Well, SL 301 No. 364 Well, SL 301 No. 369 Well, SL 301 No. 377 Well and the SL 301 No. 86 Well should be designated as the ten (10) alternate unit wells for the unit created herein.
5. To provide that the operator of the TB2G-6 RA SUA, can produce the unit allowable from the unit well, the alternate unit wells or any combination thereof.
6. To provide that the TB2G-6 Zone, Reservoir A, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
7. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the TB2G-6 Zone, Reservoir A, by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner of Conservation.
8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The TB2G-6 Zone, Reservoir A was fully defined in Order No. 411-VVVV, effective February 23, 2010.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
