Application is hereby made on behalf of **ARK-LA-TEX ENERGY PARTNERS, LLC**, (Applicant), to the Commissioner of Conservation for a Public Hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Pettet Formation, Reservoir A, Hosston Formation and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, Bethany Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To re-define the Hosston Formation, **INSOFAR AND ONLY INSOFAR**, as it concerns the HOSS SU39, as that gas and condensate productive interval encountered between the depths of 6,750 feet to 9,530 feet (electric log measurements) in the ARK-LA-TEX Energy Partners, LLC – Gamble et al 3 No. 1 well, located in Section 3, Township 13 North, Range 15 West, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, such unit and well shown on the attached plat and made a part hereof.
2. To authorize a substitute unit well for the production of gas and condensate from the Hosston Formation, Reservoir A, in the unit designated HOSS SU39.
3. To permit the unit operator of the PET RA SU64, HOSS SU39 and the CV RA SUC to downhole combine the production from the Pettet Formation, Reservoir A, the Hosston Formation and the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in any existing well bore within the units and any future well(s) that may be drilled within the units.
4. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem pertinent and appropriate.

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The Pettet Zone, Reservoir A, was initially defined in Bethany Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana, in Office of Conservation Order No. 289, effective October 1, 1954, and was redefined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-2, effective May 9, 1956.

The Hosston Formation was originally defined in the Bethany Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana, in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-A-g-2, effective April 14, 1977 and is to be re-defined in accordance with No. 1 hereof.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, was defined in Bethany Longstreet Field, Caddo and DeSoto Parishes, Louisiana, in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-J, effective March 4, 1977.

The pertinent data pertaining to this Application is available for inspection at the offices of Bob F. Anderson, PE, Inc., 400 Travis Street, Suite 209, Shreveport, Louisiana 71101. A copy of this letter, plat and list of parties is being sent to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Shreveport District Office of Conservation.

Attached hereto is our check, made payable to the Office of Conservation, to cover the applicable hearing fee.


