

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 15, 2011**, upon the application of **CHAPARRAL ENERGY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **SD 1-4 Zone, Reservoir A, SUA and SUB**, in the Oakley Field, Assumption Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the SD 1-4 Zone, Reservoir A SUA and SUB.
2. To create drilling and production units for the exploration and production of gas and condensate from the SD 1-4 Zone, Reservoir A SUA and SUB, such proposed units being shown on the plat submitted with the application and being designated as SD 1-4 Zone, Reservoir A SUA and SUB.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis.
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such a reclassification be warranted based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The SD 1-4 Zone is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the electric log depths of 13,023' and 13,359' in the Union Oil Co.-J. Aron No. 1-A Well (SN 148256) located in Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 14 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
