**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 15, 2011**, upon the application of **LOUISIANA TANK, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **14,500' Geothermal Zone, Reservoir A**, in the North Sweet Lake Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of geothermal resources from the 14,500' Geothermal Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for this zone and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, geothermal leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created.
4. To provide that any geothermal resources well drilled inside the unit established for the 14,500' Geothermal Zone, Reservoir A shall be exempt from spacing requirements.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 14,500' Geothermal Zone, Reservoir A is hereby defined as being that geothermal resources bearing zone encountered between the depths of 14,568' to 16,000' (electrical log measurements) in the Flores & Rucks, Inc. – William B. Hebert Est. No. 1 Well (SN 216999), located in Section 17, Township 12 South, Range 7 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
