Application is hereby made on behalf of CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC., for the calling of a public hearing, after thirty (30) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters related to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bienville and Bossier Parishes, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 691-C, effective November 18, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 691-C Series of Orders, to-wit:

- 1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such unit to be designated HA RA SUZ;
- To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;

- 3. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of, and a unit well for the proposed unit, if appropriate;
- 4. To provide that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within or to serve the proposed unit, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset well(s) should be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
- 5. To extend to the proposed unit, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 691-C, effective November 18, 2008, as amended and supplemented by the 691-C Series of Orders, and all applicable Statewide Orders; and
- 6. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Swan Lake Field, Bienville and Bossier Parishes, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 691-C, effective November 18, 2008.

The pre-application conference tentatively scheduled for February 3, 2011, <u>WILL</u> <u>NOT BE HELD</u>, as it was not requested within the delays provided for by the Rules of Procedure; therefore, no opposition to this Application at the hearing is anticipated.
