In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on TUESDAY, MARCH 1, 2011, upon the application of EXCO OPERATING COMPANY, LP.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Zone**, **Reservoir A**, in the Holly Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

- 1. To permit the Applicant to drill, designate and utilize seven (7) alternate unit wells for the production of gas and condensate for the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the unit designated HA RA SUZZ.
- 2. To find that alternate unit wells are necessary, at the locations shown on the plat submitted with the application, to assist in draining a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the unit designated HA RA SUZZ that cannot be drained by any other well located within the unit.
- 3. To find that with respect to horizontal well(s) to be drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within or to serve the HA RA SUZZ, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset well(s) shall be calculated based on the distance from the nearest perforations in the well and not based on the penetration or terminus point.
- 4. To permit the unit operator to produce the assigned unit allowable from the unit well, the alternate unit wells or from a combination of all wells, at its discretion.
- 5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 88-J, effective July 29, 2009.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in Baton Rouge and Shreveport, Louisiana.
