

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 1, 2011**, upon the application of **BOPCO, LP**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **BN-1/BN-8 Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Cox Bay Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit Applicant to drill, designate and utilize an additional alternate unit well for BN-1/BN-8 RA SUB at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, or at any location within forty (40) feet of the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, in exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E (LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq).
2. To find that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the BN-1/BN-8 Zone, Reservoir A, underlying BN-1/BN-8 RA SUB which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such unit.
3. To provide that the Operator of BN-1/BN-8 RA SUB may produce the allowable assigned to the unit from the unit well, from any alternate unit well, or from any combination of such wells, at the option of the Operator.
4. Except insofar as set forth above, to confirm and continue in effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 198-B, effective July 31, 2007, the units created thereby, and applicable Statewide Orders.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The BN-1/BN-8 Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 198-B, effective July 31, 2007.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
