BOPCO, L.P. ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the BN-1/BN-8 Zone, Reservoir A, in the Cox Bay Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit Applicant to drill, designate and utilize an additional alternate unit well for BN-1/BN-8 RA SUB at the location shown on the attached plat, or at any location within forty (40) feet of the location shown on the attached plat, in exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E (LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq).

2. To find that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the BN-1/BN-8 Zone, Reservoir A, underlying BN-1/BN-8 RA SUB which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such unit.

3. To provide that the Operator of BN-1/BN-8 RA SUB may produce the allowable assigned to the unit from the unit well, from any alternate unit well, or from any combination of such wells, at the option of the Operator.

4. Except insofar as set forth above, to confirm and continue in effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 198-B, effective July 31, 2007, the units created thereby, and applicable Statewide Orders.

5. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

The BN-1/BN-8 Zone, Reservoir A, in the Cox Bay Field, Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 198-B, effective July 31, 2007.

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Any pertinent data concerning this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 North Causeway Boulevard, Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002-7216. Any person desiring to inspect any such data should call Mr. Louis Gilbert at (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such data which is not otherwise available at the Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.


As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.
