Application is hereby made on behalf of Hilcorp Energy Company to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the E-1 Sand, Reservoir B and the E-4 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lake Barre Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the E-1 Sand, Reservoir B and the E-4 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lake Barre Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for each of these sands and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.
3. To designate Hilcorp Energy Company as operator of the E-1 RB SUA and the E-4 RA SUA.
4. To designate Hilcorp's Lake Barre Unit 32 No. 30 Well as the unit well for the E-1 RB SUA and the E-4 RA SUA.
5. To provide that the E-1 Sand, Reservoir B and the E-4 Sand, Reservoir A should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the Reservoirs by supplemental orders and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.
7. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The E-1 Sand, Reservoir B, in the Lake Barre Field, is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,603' to 10,632' electric log measured depths (10,591' to 10,619' true vertical depths) in the Hilcorp Energy Company - Lake Barre Unit 33 No. 21 Well, located in Township 21 South, Range 20 East, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

The E-4 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Lake Barre Field, is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,908' to 10,968' electric log measured depths (10,892' to 10,951' true vertical depths) in the Hilcorp Energy Company - Lake Barre Unit 33 No. 21 Well, located in Township 21 South, Range 20 East, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plats in a prominent place in the area of the Lake Barre Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the Lake Barre Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.

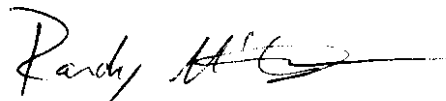
In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a preapplication notice was given, but no request for a conference was received, and therefore, none was held.

A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, Hilcorp Energy Company, in the sum of \$1510.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.

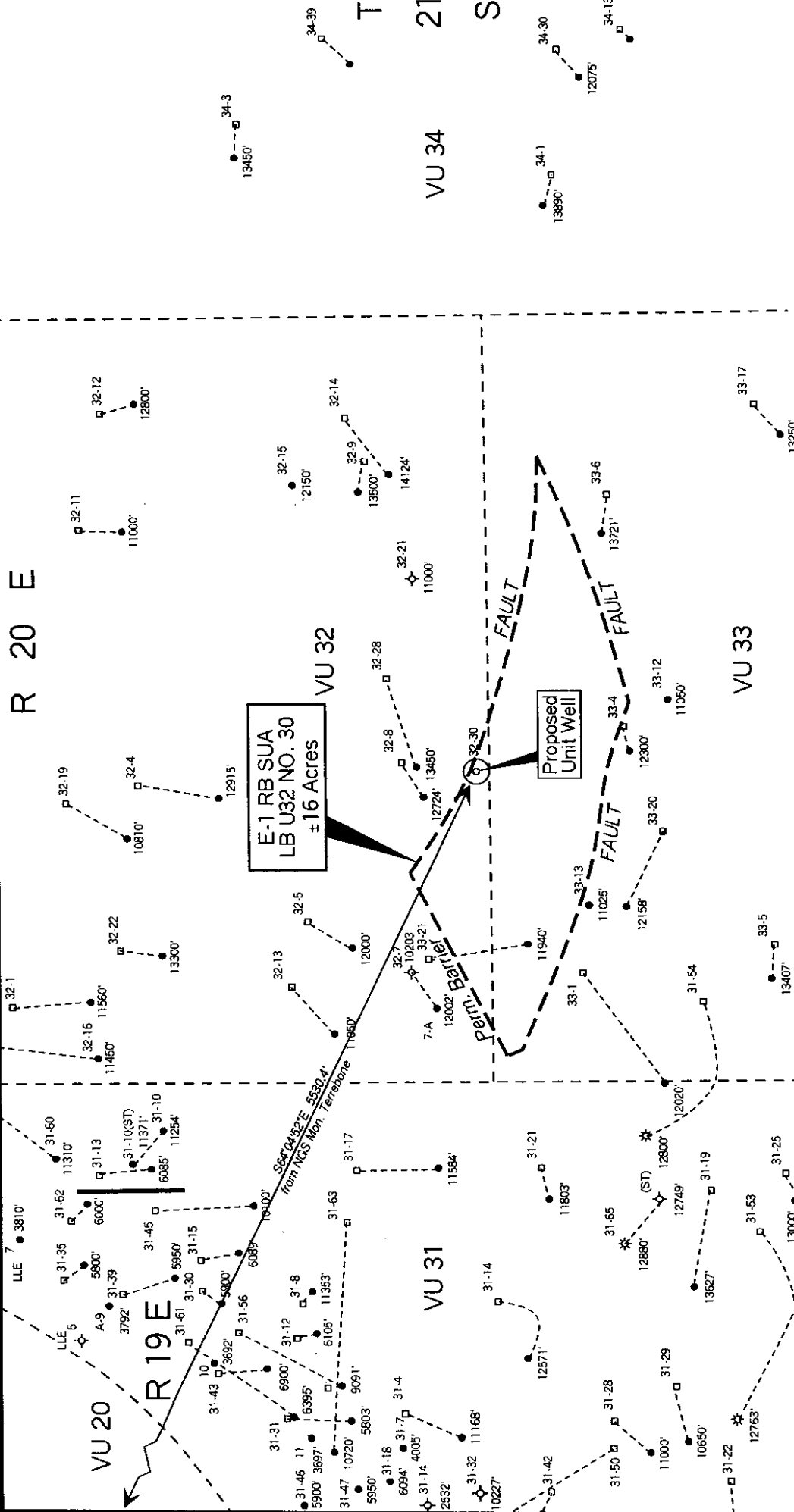
