

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 15, 2011**, upon the application of **MATADOR PRODUCTION COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Thorn Lake Field, Red River Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize Applicant to drill, designate and utilize six (6) horizontal wells as additional alternate unit wells for HA RA SUB, at the locations shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To find that each of the proposed alternate unit wells is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, underlying HA RA SUB which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such unit.
3. To permit the operator of HA RA SUB to produce the allowable assigned to this unit from either the unit well, from any alternate unit well, or from any combination of such wells, at the option of the Operator.
4. To provide that with respect to any horizontal well drilled to the Haynesville Zone within HA RA SUB, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, the distance to any unit boundary or offset well will be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well and not based on the penetration point or terminus of the well in the Haynesville Zone.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1145-B, effective July 15, 2008.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
