

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 29, 2011**, upon the application of **ZACHRY EXPLORATION, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Miocene Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Richie Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create three (3) drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the units so created.
4. To provide that any wells drilled to the Miocene Zone, Reservoir A shall be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Orders without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished by the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Miocene Zone, Reservoir A is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 3,430' and 4,190' electric log measured depths in the DBL;Ernie N. Vige No. 1 Well, located in Section 32, Township 7 South, Range 1 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
