Dear Mr. Commissioner:

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Louisiana, application is hereby made on behalf of Cocke Heirs, et al for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the MA-11 Zone, Reservoir B, SUB in the Duck Lake Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana:

1. To create an additional single drilling and production unit of approximately 398 acres for the MA-11 Zone, Reservoir B, SUB, Duck Lake Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana, designated as the MA-11 RB SUB, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat;
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said sand unit;
3. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with this notice, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 174-M shall remain in full force and effect, and
4. To consider such other matters relating to the subject reservoir as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

The MA-11 Zone, in the Duck Lake Field was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 174-M, effective November 8, 2005.

The Commissioner of Conservation has waived the twenty (20) day pre-application notice requirement provided for in Rule 3 of the Rules of

Procedure for Conducting Hearings Before the Commissioner of Conservation and that rule is not applicable to this hearing application.

A conference to discuss the unit proposed herein and the bases thereof WILL BE HELD at 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, February 10, 2011, at the offices of Liskow & Lewis, 822 Harding Street, Lafayette, Louisiana 70503.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the MA-11 RB SUB, Duck Lake Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana, and a list of the names and addresses of the interested owners and represented parties who are being furnished with copies of this hearing application. This list includes the names and addresses of all interested parties who are known to the applicant after a reasonable search. It is hereby certified that a reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, represented parties and interested parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this hearing application. Should any such party desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.

Upon receipt of the legal notice in the captioned matter, the notice will be posted, published and mailed in accordance with Rule 8 of the Rules of Procedure.


