

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 22, 2011**, upon the application of **ALTA MESA SERVICES, LP**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **BF-4 Sand, Reservoir A, SUD**, in the Weeks Island Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit applicant, Alta Mesa Services, LP to drill, designate and utilize the Alta Mesa Services, LP-Alta Mesa Services, LP-Goodrich-Cocke No. 9 Well as an alternate unit well for the BF-4 RA SUD, such well to be at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the BF-4 RA SUD which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit.
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the BF-4 RA SUD and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or from any combination at its option.
4. To confirm Alta Mesa Services, LP as the operator of the BF-4 RA SUD.
5. To find that, except to the extent contrary in the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 146-WW-3, effective August 1, 2006, shall remain in full force and effect.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The BF-4 Sand, Reservoir A was previously defined in Order No. 146-WW-3, effective August 1, 2006.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
