

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 22, 2011**, upon the application of **ENCANA OIL & GAS (USA) INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Caspiana Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

1. To grant a spacing exception to allow the applicant to continue to utilize its Jackson Davis 26H No. 7 Alt. Well as alternate unit well to serve the HA RA SU54, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, which location is in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007.
2. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 191-H Series, the units created thereby, and applicable Statewide Orders.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
