LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 22, 2011**, upon the application of **ENERGEN RESOURCES CORPORATION**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston A Zone and Hosston B Zone**, in the Sailes Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize Applicant to drill, designate and utilize a substitute unit well for HOSS A SUYY and an alternate unit well for HOSS B SUYY, at the location shown on the plats submitted with the application, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 408-A, effective August 1, 1970.
2. To find that the proposed well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Hosston A and B Zones underlying HOSS A SUYY and HOSS B SUYY which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such units.
3. To provide that the operator of HOSS B SUYY may be produce the allowable assigned to the unit from either the unit well, from the alternate unit well, or from a combination thereof, at the option of the operator.
4. Except insofar as may be in conflict with these proposals, to confirm and continue in effect the provisions of Order No. 408-A, effective August 1, 1970, as amended and supplemented by the Order No. 408-A Series of Orders, the units created thereby, and of all applicable Statewide Orders.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston A Zone was defined in Order No. 408-A, effective August 1, 1970.

The Hosston B Zone was defined in Order No. 408-A-1, effective February 18, 1971.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
