Hosston A & B Zones, SAILES FIELD, Bienville  
Parish, Louisiana.

Dear Sir:

ENERGEN RESOURCES CORPORATION ("Applicant") hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston A Zone and to the Hosston B Zone in the Sailes Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize Applicant to drill, designate and utilize a substitute unit well for HOSS A SUYY, and an alternate unit well for HOSS B SUYY, at the location shown on the attached plats, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 408-A, effective August 1, 1970.
2. To find that the proposed well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Hosston A and B Zones underlying HOSS A SUYY and HOSS B SUYY which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such units.
3. To provide that the operator of HOSS B SUYY may produce the allowable assigned to the unit from either the unit well, from the alternate unit well, or from a combination thereof, at the option of the operator.
4. Except insofar as may be in conflict with these proposals, to confirm and continue in effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 408-A, effective August 1, 1970, as amended and supplemented by the Order No. 408-A series of Orders, the units created thereby, and of all applicable Statewide Orders.
5. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

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The Hosston A Zone in Sailes Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 408-A, effective August 1, 1970. The Hosston B Zone in Sailes Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 408-A-1, effective February 18, 1971.



A copy of any such data which is not otherwise available at the Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.

As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Pursuant to the aforesaid Rules of Procedure, Applicant has made a reasonable effort to obtain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom notice of this application is being sent and has attached hereto a list of the names and addresses of such parties. A copy of this letter and of the attached plats is being sent to the District Manager of the Shreveport District of the Office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties, as shown on the attached list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and the enclosed plats at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of Sailes Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

A check payable to the Office of Conservation and covering the application fee is enclosed.

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


-  PROPOSED ALTERNATE UNIT WELL
