LEGAL NOTICE

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MARCH 22, 2011**, upon the application of **WILDHORSE RESOURCES, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Burgess-Simmons Sand**, in the Lisbon Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize Wildhorse Resources, LLC to drill, designate and utilize a substitute unit well for BS SUK at the exceptional location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To establish that the proposed substitute unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Burgess-Simmons Sand underlying BS SUK.
3. To the extent necessary, to approve the location of the proposed substitute unit well as an exception to the field spacing rules for the Burgess-Simmons Sand.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Burgess-Simmons Sand was defined in Order No. 9-C, effective November 10, 1945.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
