LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 12, 2011**, upon the application of **SWIFT ENERGY OPERATING, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Austin Chalk Zone, Reservoir A**, in the South Burr Ferry Field, Vernon Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize a horizontal alternate unit well for the AUS C RA SUF, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, or within a tolerance radius of 100' thereof to account for any slight variation between the proposed location and the actual "as drilled" location, in exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1409, effective January 8, 1997.
2. To find that the proposed horizontal alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the reservoir covered by the unit which cannot be so drained by any existing well in the unit.
3. To permit the operator of the AUS C RA SUF to produce the unit allowable from the existing unit well and the proposed alternate unit well, or both, at its option.
4. Except to the extent herein set forth to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Order No. 1409, effective January 8, 1997, as amended and supplemented by the 1409-A Series of Orders, and applicable Statewide Orders.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Austin Chalk Zone, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 1409, effective January 8, 1997.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
