In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY**, **APRIL 26**, **2011**, upon the application of **PIONEER EXPLORATION**, **LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the M Sand, Reservoir C, in the Kings Bayou Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

- 1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E) and Office of Conservation Order No. 638, effective September 1, 1963 and to create a single drilling and production unit.
- 2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said unit.
- 3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
- 4. To designate a unit operator and unit well for the unit created herein.
- 5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The M Sand was previously defined in Order No. 638, effective September 1, 1963 and was further defined in Order No. 638-C-2, effective May 15, 1969, and is hereby defined for Reservoir C as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 13,484' and 13,532' (electrical log measurements) (12,933' – 12,981' vd) in the Pioneer Exploration, LLC (formerly Union Pacific Resources) – B. C. Welch, Sr., et al No. 1 Well, located in Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 6 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in Baton Rouge and Lafayette, Louisiana.
