

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, APRIL 26, 2011**, upon the application of **INDIAN EXPLORATION, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **6,620' Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Reddell Field, Evangeline Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create a single drilling and production unit for the 6,620' Sand, Reservoir A.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the said unit.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate a unit well and an alternate unit well and unit operator for the proposed unit created herein.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 6,620' Sand is hereby defined as that interval from 6,628'-6,670' MD (6,545'-6,587' SS) in the Indian Exploration, Inc. (Woods Petroleum Corp.)-Joseph M. Haas No. 1 Well located in Section 22, Township 4 South, Range 1 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
