- 4. Except to the extent herein set forth, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Order No. 570-C-14, effective October 11, 2005, as amended and supplemented by Order No. 570-C-15, effective May 1, 2007, and applicable Statewide Orders.
- 5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The MA-7 Zone, Reservoir D was defined in Order No. 570-C-14, effective October 11, 2005 and redefined in Order No. 570-C-15, effective May 1, 2007.
