MARQUETTE EXPLORATION, LLC ("Applicant"), hereby respectfully applies for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Hosston Zone and the Mooringsport Zone in the Driscoll Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana:

1. To approve the downhole combination of production from the Hosston Zone and the Mooringsport Zone in the wellbore of any well located in Section 33, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, in which the ownership interests in these zones are identical.
2. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.
3. To continue in full force and effect, except as contrary to these proposals, the provisions of the Office of Conservation Order No. 194-B series of orders, the units created thereby, and of all applicable Statewide Orders.

The Hosston Zone in the Driscoll Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 194-B, effective October 1, 1966.

The Mooringsport Zone in the Driscoll Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, for the purpose of these proposals, is defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the depths of 5,046 feet and 5,180 feet, electric log measurements, in the Brammer Engineering, Inc.--Davis Bros. 33 No. 1 Well, located in Section 33, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Bienville Parish, Louisiana.

As shown on the attached plat, the entirety of Section 33, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, is covered by a single mineral lease, and the entirety of this

section has been established as a drilling and production unit for the Hosston Zone by Office of Conservation Order No. 194-B, effective October 1, 1966, this Hosston Zone unit being designated HOSS SUA. As a result, the ownership interests in the Hosston Zone and the Mooringsport Zone are uniform throughout this area.

Any pertinent data concerning this application will be available for inspection at the offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 3636 N. Causeway Blvd., Suite 204, Metairie, Louisiana 70002-7216. Any person desiring to inspect any such data should call Mr. Gilbert at (504) 834-8112 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such data which is not otherwise available at the Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.


As provided by the Revised Rules of Procedure, the subject matter of this application does not require the issuance of a pre-application notice; therefore, no such notice has been issued.

Furthermore, Applicant will mail a copy of the Legal Notice to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

A check payable to the Office of Conservation and covering the application fee is enclosed.
