Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **ANADARKO E&P COMPANY, LP** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Austin Chalk Zone, Reservoir B, in the North Bayou Jack Field, Avoyelles and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana:

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Austin Chalk Zone, Reservoir B, in the North Bayou Jack Field, Avoyelles and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana, said unit to be designated AUS C RB SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that any future wells drilled to the aforementioned zone and reservoir, within or outside the unit created herein, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify said zone and reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of such reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.

5. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Austin Chalk Zone, in North Bayou Jack Field, Avoyelles and St. Landry Parishes, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1042-A, effective April 29, 1992.






