

**LEGAL NOTICE**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 3, 2011**, upon the application of **HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **13,150' Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Deep Lake Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To find that the 13,150 RA SUA, SUB, SUC and SUD created by Office of Conservation Order No. 243-B-2, effective March 1, 1968 and dissolved by Order No. 243-B-4, effective July 20, 1983 meet all the requirements necessary for termination by R.S. 30:9.1 and Statewide Order No. 29-L-3 and therefore such provisions should be applied to specifically terminate these dissolved units.
2. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 13,150' Sand was fully defined in Order No. 243-B, dated July 9, 1962.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
