

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 3, 2011**, upon the application of **KAISER-FRANCIS OIL COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Het Zone, Reservoir B**, in the Crowley Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Het Zone, Reservoir B.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for this zone and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created.
3. To designate Kaiser-Francis Oil Company as operator of the HET RB SUA.
4. To designate the Kaiser-Francis Oil Company – J. Baronet No. 2 Well as the unit well for HET RB SUA.
5. To provide that the Het Zone, Reservoir B, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoir by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Het Zone, Reservoir B is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between 9,673' to 9,774' electric log measured depths (9,577' to 9,674' tvd) in the Kaiser-Francis Oil Company-J. Baronet No. 2 Well (formerly Jeffers No. 1), located in Section 10, Township 10 South, Range 1 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
