Forest Oil Corporation, ("Applicant") hereby makes application to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Operc 5 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Bayou Postillion Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Operc 5 Sand, Reservoir A.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Operc 5 Sand, Reservoir A.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Operc 5 Sand, Reservoir A, shall be exempt from the well spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the Reservoir changes and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Operc 5 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Bayou Postillion Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,772' and 10,780' (electrical log measurements) in the Forest Oil Corporation (formerly LLOG Exploration Company)- H.R. Goodrich, et al No. 2 well (WSN

220706); located in Section 35, Township 12 South, Range 11 East, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

A conference to discuss the proposed unit and the basis thereof was tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, April 6, 2011 in the pre-application notice dated March 16, 2011. No request for the conference was received, therefore the conference WILL NOT BE HELD. No opposition is expected at the public hearing to be held in conjunction with this matter.

All pertinent data that is not otherwise available from the Office of Conservation can be obtained at the expense of the requesting party from the undersigned.

There is no a plat attached to this application as there have been no alterations or changes to the plat attached to the pre-application notice.

There is attached hereto and made a part hereof, a plat outlining the proposed unit and a list of names and addresses of the Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties to whom this notice is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of Parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. The aforementioned list is available upon request to any Interested Party. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties as required by the Revised Rules of Procedure.

There is enclosed herewith on behalf of the Applicant a check made payable to the Office of Conservation, representing the required hearing application fee.
