Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A**, in the **Caspiana Field**, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a pattern of drilling and production units was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 191-H Series of Orders, to-wit:

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, such unit to be designated HA RA SU161;
2. To redefine the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, in the Caspiana Field, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar as the proposed unit referenced herein is concerned, in accordance with the DEFINITION section hereof;

3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation;
4. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as the operator of, and a unit well for the proposed unit, if appropriate;
5. To provide that with respect to horizontal wells drilled to the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, within or to serve the proposed unit, where the horizontal portion of the well is cased and cemented back above the top of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir A, the distance to any unit boundary and any offset well(s) should be calculated based on the distance to the nearest perforation in the well, and not based on the penetration point or terminus;
6. To extend to the proposed unit, to the extent not inconsistent herewith, all pertinent provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, as amended and supplemented by the 191-H Series of Orders; and
7. To consider such other matters as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the hearing.

DEFINITION - The Haynesville Zone, in the Caspiana Field, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 191-H, effective August 28, 2007, and is hereby redefined, INsofar AND ONLY INsofar as the proposed unit referenced herein is concerned, as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 10,055 feet and 11,487 feet, electrical log measurements, in the Chesapeake Operating, Inc. - SRLT 29 No. 1 Well, located in Section 29, Township 16 North, Range 15 West, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

Pursuant to Rule 8 of the Rules of Procedure, the Commissioner of Conservation has waived the pre-application notice requirement. **A conference to discuss the proposed application is hereby scheduled for Thursday, April 21, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. at the Petroleum Club of Shreveport, 416 Travis St # 1500, Energy Room C, Shreveport, LA 71101, (318) 425-4251.**




