At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the K-3 Sand, Reservoir C2 and L-1 Sand, Reservoir G, in the Lake Barre Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

- 1. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company-LB U31 No. 67-D Well, located as shown on the plat submitted with the application, as a substitute unit well for the K-3 RC2 SUA.
- 2. To find the proposed substitute unit well is necessary and in the interest of conservation to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the K-3 RC2 SUA which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within such unit. The present unit well, the LB U31 No. 65 Well, never produced from the K-3 RC2 SUA.
- 3. To designate the Hilcorp Energy Company-LB U31 No. 67 Well, located as shown on the plat submitted with the application, as a substitute unit well for the L-1 RG SUA.
- 4. To find the proposed substitute unit well is necessary and in the interest of conversation to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the L-1 RG SUA which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within such unit. The present unti well, the LB U31 No. 65 Well never produced from the L-1 RG SUA.
- 5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The K-3 Sand, Reservoir C2 was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 662-T, effective May 4, 1983.

The L-1 Sand, Reservoir G was fully defined in Order No. 662-D-1, effective March 14, 1989.
