LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 24, 2011**, upon the application of **SUNNYSIDE RESOURCES, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Port Hudson Field, East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created in accordance with Section 10, Title 30 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, with each separate tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To provide that future wells drilled to the Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A within or outside of the proposed unit shall be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).
4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by Supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 17,030' to 18,120' (electrical log measurements) in the LL&E Exploration Company-W. J. Decker No. 1 Well (WSN 170986), located in Section 71, Township 5 South, Range 1 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
