**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 10, 2011**, upon the application of **YUMA EXPLORATION AND PRODUCTION COMPANY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir C**, in the Beaver Dam Creek Field, St. Helena and Livingston Parishes, Louisiana.

1. To permit Applicant to drill, designate and utilize its Weyerhaeuser No. 3 Well, located as shown on the plat submitted with the application, as an alternate unit well for the Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir C, Sand Unit A, designated L TUSC RC SUA, as per Office of Conservation Order No. 1317-A-5, effective April 6, 2010, which is in compliance with the spacing provisions of Order No. 1317-A-5 and Statewide Order No. 29-E.
2. To find that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir C, underlying L TUSC RC SUA, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well within the unit.
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the L TUSC RC SUA and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowable from the unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or from a combination of such wells in the unit, at its option.
4. To find that, except to the extent contrary in the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Order No. 1317-A-5, effective April 6, 2010, remain in full force and effect.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Tuscaloosa Sand was defined in Order No. 1317-A, effective December 15, 1987.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
