

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 10, 2011**, upon the application of **MILAGRO EXPLORATION, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Burdin ST UN 5**, in the West Lake Verret Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana.

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 30, effective July 16, 1941 and to permit applicant to drill, utilize and designate the State Unit 5 No. 9 Well, as a substitute unit well for the J RA SUE, all as shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. The proposed well is necessary because the present unit well, the State Unit 5-8 is unable to produce in the J RA SUE.
3. To confirm Milagro Exploration, LLC as the operator of the well to be drilled in the unit.
4. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Order No. 30, effective July 16, 1941, shall remain in full force and effect.
5. To find that a tolerance of no closer than 50 feet from the nearest unit line for the proposed well is necessary to account for the possible variance between the proposed location and the "as drilled" location.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The J Sand, Reservoir A is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 6,189' and 6,300' (electrical log measurements) in the Shell-Burdin St. Unit 5 No. 8 Well (formerly Burdin St. Un 4 No. 5 Well) (SN129888), located in Section 15, Township 14 South, Range 12 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
