Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **Milagro Exploration, LLC** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Burdin ST UN 5, in the West Lake Verret Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana.

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E) and Office of Conservation Order No. 30, effective July 16, 1941 to permit the drilling of a well, the Burdin ST UN 5 No. 9 Well, for the Burdin ST UN 5, West Lake Verret Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat.
2. To confirm Milagro Exploration, LLC as the operator of the well to be drilled in the unit.
3. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 30, effective July 16, 1941, shall remain in full force and effect;
4. To find that a tolerance of no closer than 50 feet from the nearest unit line for the proposed well is necessary to account for the possible variance between the proposed location and the "as drilled" location.
5. To consider such other matters relating to the subject unit as may be appropriate and justified by the evidence presented at the public hearing.

Subsequent to the filing of its application dated March 23, 2011 for the captioned, applicant hereby revises its application as follows:

1. The unit was originally the Burdin ST UN 5 and is amended to J RA SUE.
2. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E) and Office of Conservation Order No. 30, effective July 16, 1941 and to permit applicant to drill, utilize and designate the State Unit 5 No. 9 Well, as a substitute unit well for the J RA SUE, West Lake Verret Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana, all as shown more particularly on the attached plat.
3. This well is necessary because the present unit well, the State Unit 5-8 is unable to produce in the J RA SUE.
4. The J RA SUE in the West Lake Verret Field, St. Martin Parish, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 30, effective July 16, 1941.

Attached is a copy of the revised unit plat which is also furnished to all interested owners, represented parties and interested parties to whom the application was sent. In all other respects, the application shall be as originally filed.

Subsequent to the filing of its application dated March 23, 2011 and supplement notice of April 6, 2011 for the captioned, applicant hereby revises its application insofar and only insofar as to the definition, as follows:

The J Sand, Reservoir A in the West Lake Verret Field is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 6,189 feet and 6,300 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Shell-Burdin St. Unit 5 No. 8 Well (formerly Burdin St. Un 4 No. 5 Well) (SN129888), located in Section 15, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana.

In all other respects, the application shall be as originally filed.
