

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 10, 2011**, upon the application of **BURK ROYALTY CO., LTD.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A**, in the McKenzie Field, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize an alternate unit well for CV RA SUJ, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To explicitly find that the proposed alternate unit well is in the interest of conservation and is necessary to drain a portion of the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, underlying CV RA SUJ, which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well in such unit.
3. To provide that the unit allowable for CV RA SUJ, may be produced from either the unit well, the alternate unit well, or any combination thereof, at the operator's discretion.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A is fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1074, effective September 19, 1979.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
