

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 17, 2011**, upon the application of **WILDHORSE RESOURCES, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A**, in the Terryville Field, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize Wildhorse Resources, LLC to drill, designate and utilize an additional alternate unit well for LCV RA SUH at the exceptional location shown on the plat submitted with the application, in lieu of the location approved by Office of Conservation Order No. 370-B-169, effective October 19, 2010.
2. To establish that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Lower Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, underlying LCV RA SUH.
3. To authorize the unit allowable for this unit to be recovered from the unit well, the existing alternate unit wells, the proposed additional alternate unit well, or from any combination of such wells, at the discretion of the operator.
4. To the extent necessary, to approve the location of the proposed alternate unit well as an exception to the field spacing rules for the Lower Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A was defined in Order No. 370-B-6, effective February 18, 1982 and has been redefined as to certain units including LCV RA SUH by subsequent orders of the 370-B Series of Orders.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Shreveport**, Louisiana.
