Application is hereby made on behalf of **JOHN J. WELSH**, (Applicant), to the Commissioner of Conservation for a Public Hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Pettet Lime, Reservoir A, Cotton Valley Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana:

1. To permit the Applicant to designate and utilize an existing well bore, the John J. Welsh – L. C. Cox No. 3 Well, as an alternate unit well for the production of gas and condensate from the Pettet Lime, Reservoir A, in the unit designated PET RA SUD, in the Cotton Valley Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana, such unit and well shown on the attached plat and being made a part hereof.
2. To find that an alternate unit well is necessary, at the location shown on the attached plat, to assist in draining a portion of the Pettet Lime, Reservoir A, in the unit designated PET RA SUD that cannot be drained by any other well located within the unit.
3. To permit the unit operator to produce the assigned unit allowable from the unit well, the alternate unit wells or from a combination of all wells, at its discretion.
4. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem pertinent and appropriate.

The Pettet Lime, Reservoir A, in the Cotton Valley Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana, was initially defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 10-Z-E-2, effective November 9, 1999, and was redefined in Office of Conservation Order No. 10-Z-E-10, effective December 16, 2003.

Attached hereto is our check, made payable to the Office of Conservation, to cover the applicable hearing fee.




