LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, MAY 24, 2011**, upon the application of **EL PASO E&P COMPANY, LP.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B**, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize El Paso E&P Company, LP. to designate and utilize its Smith, et al 6H No. 1 Well as the unit well for HA RB SU57 at the exceptional location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To find that to approve the location of the proposed unit well, as drilled, is in the interest of conservation and is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B, underlying HA RB SU57 that cannot be drained by any other well located on the unit.
- 3 To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Haynesville Zone, Reservoir B was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 289-R-1, effective April 29, 2008 and was redefined as to HA RB SU57 in Order No. 289-R-42, effective September 22, 2009.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
