- 3. Except to the extent herein set forth, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 300-E, effective August 1, 1962, as amended and supplemented by the 300-E Series of Orders, and the units created thereby.
- 4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 9,200' Massive Sand was defined in Order No. 300-E, effective August 1, 1962.
