**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 14, 2011**, upon the application of **VICTOR P. SMITH OIL COMPANY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **7,500' Zone, Reservoir A, 9,000' Zone, Reservoir A and 10,500' Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Little Cheniere Field, Cameron Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the 7,500' Zone, Reservoir A, 9,000' Zone, Reservoir A and 10,500' Sand, Reservoir A.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for each zone and sand and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the units so created as may be appropriate.
4. To provide that any well drilled outside of the 7,500' Zone, Reservoir A and 10,500' Sand, Reservoir A shall be in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the 9,000' Zone, Reservoir A should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the Reservoirs by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 7,500' Zone is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 7,120' and 7,862' in the Goldking Production Company-Miami Corp. "R" No. 1 Well, located in Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 6 West.

The 9,000' Zone is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 8,862' and 9,608' (electrical log measurements) in the An-Son Petroleum Corp.-Labove No. 1 (OH) Well, located in Section 14, Township 14 South, Range 6 West.

The 10,500' Sand is hereby defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 10,416' and 10,498' (electrical log measurements) in the Gulf Refining Company-Mermentau Minerals & Land No. 1 Well, located in Section 14, Township 14 South, Range 6 West.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
