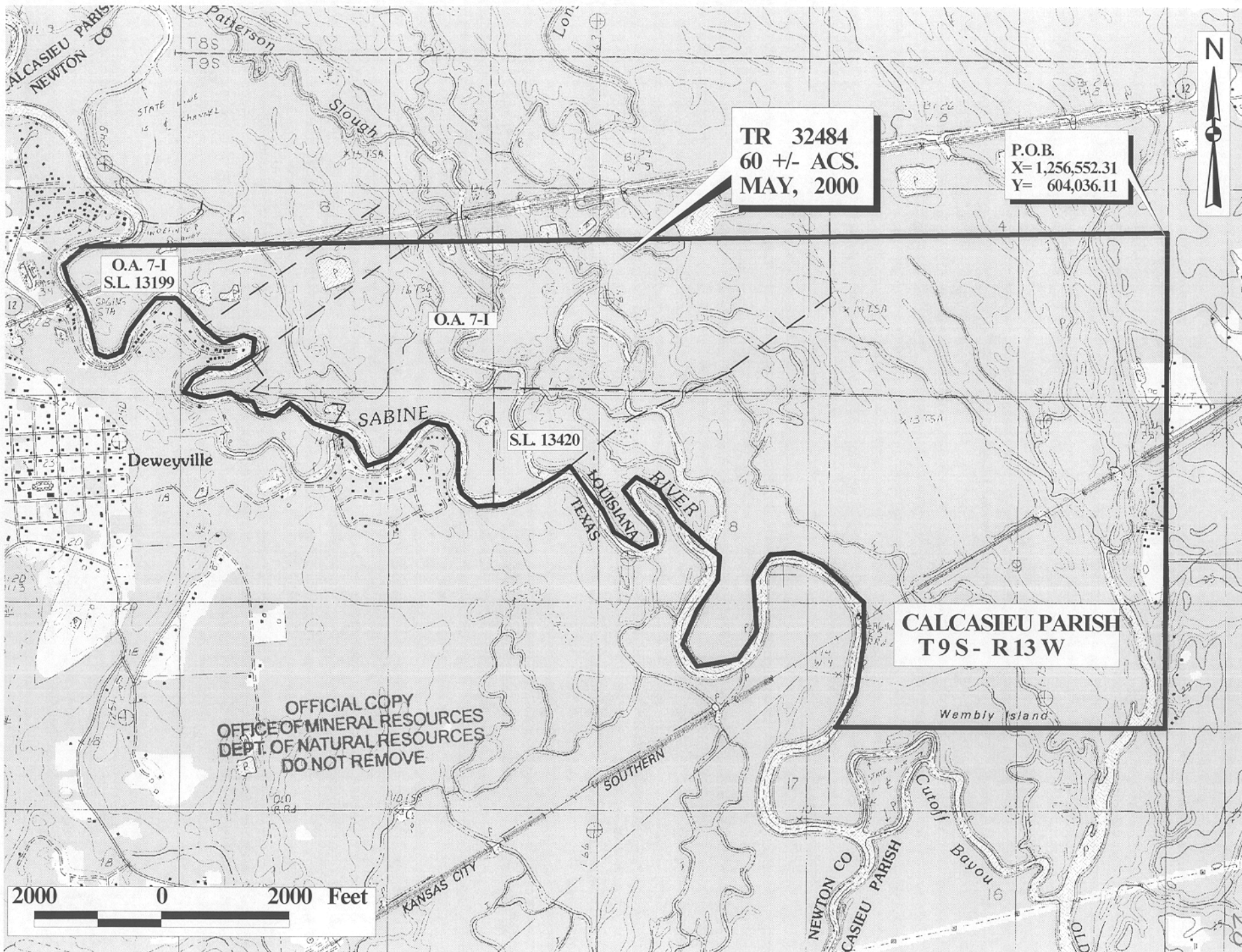


TRACT 32484 - Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana

Louisiana et al No. 36 Original, or as otherwise approved by said court. All bearings, distances and coordinates are based on Louisiana Coordinate System of 1927 (South Zone).

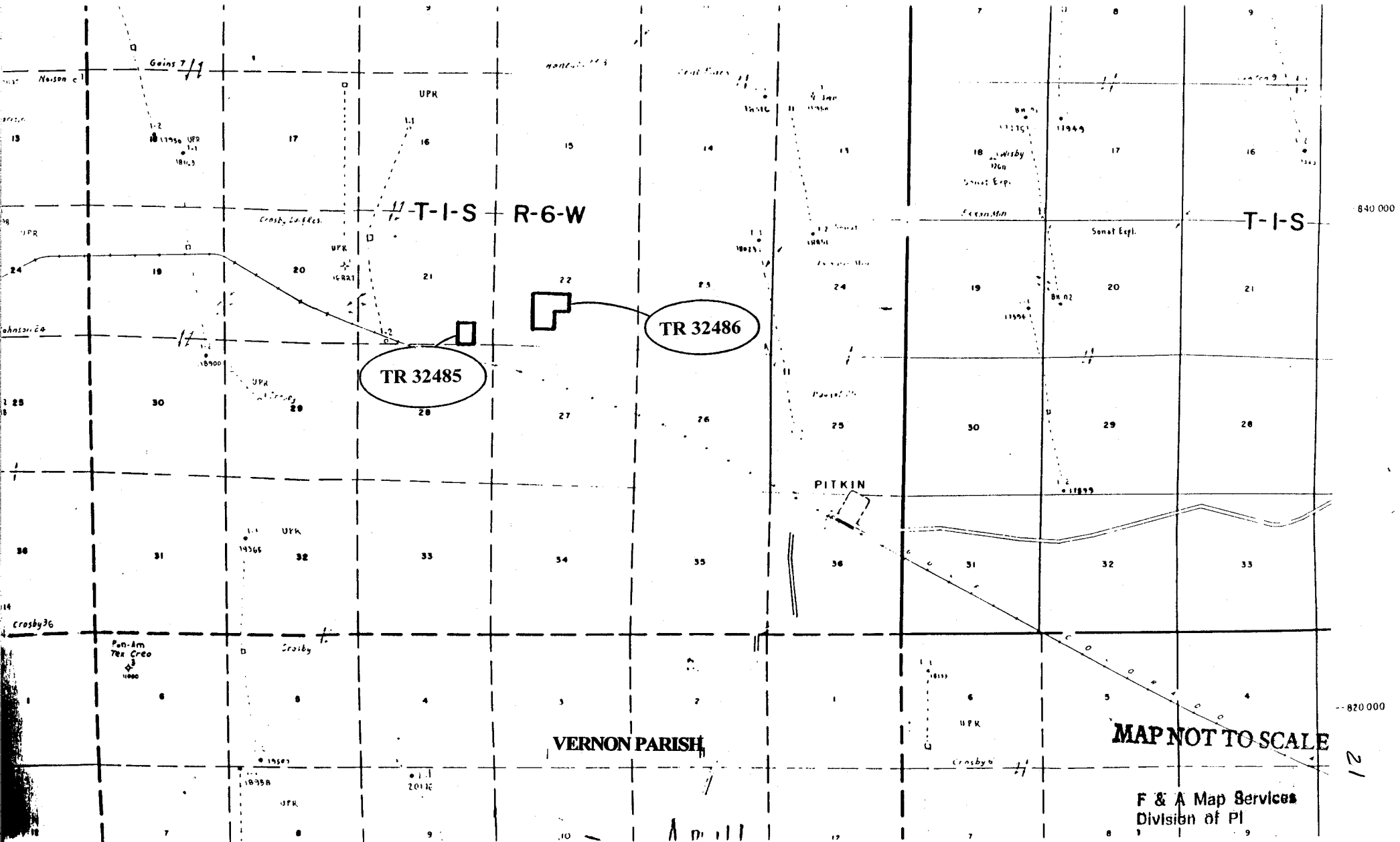

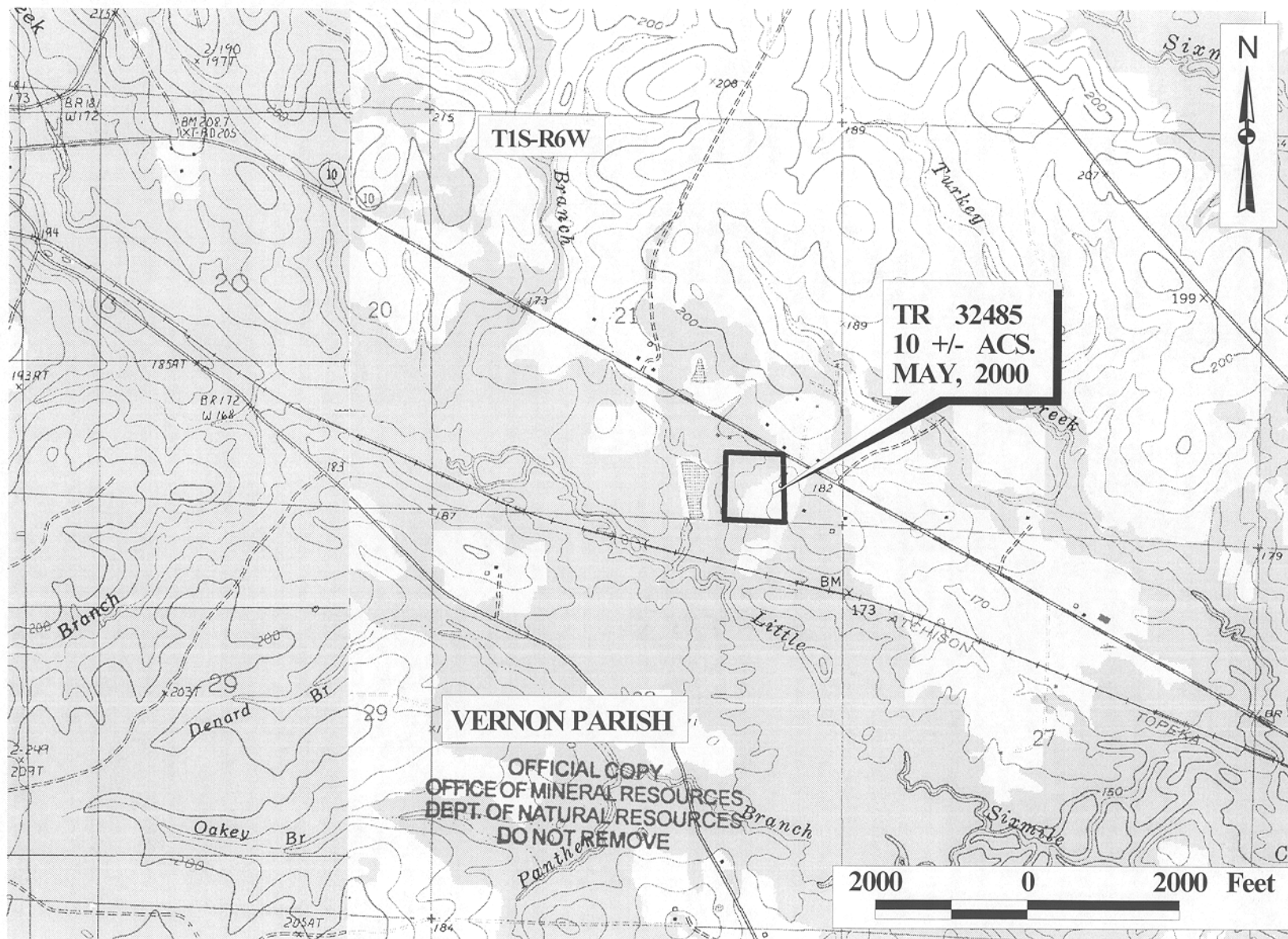
